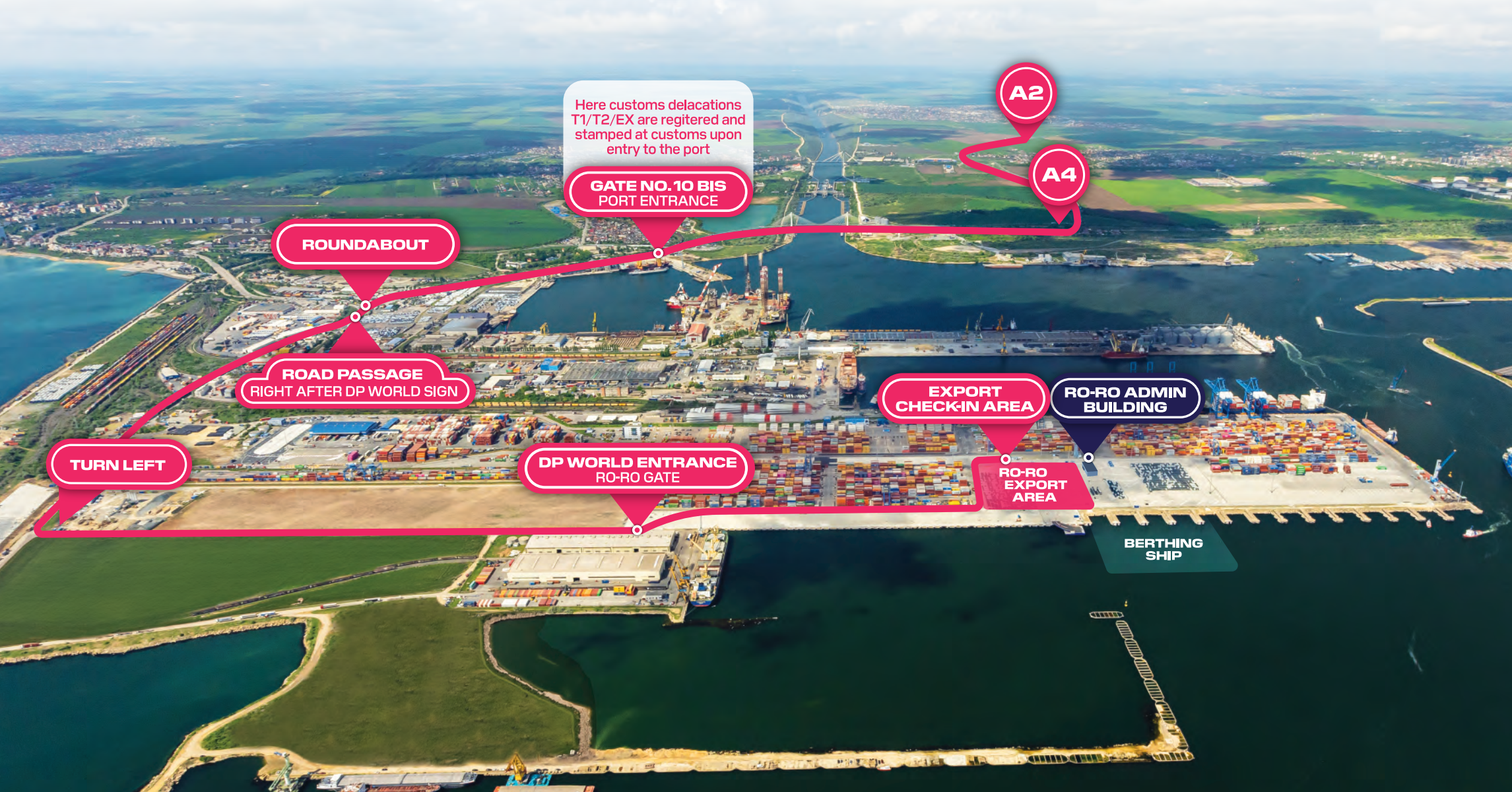


ROLL-ON TERMINAL PORT & TERMINAL ENTERING STEPS

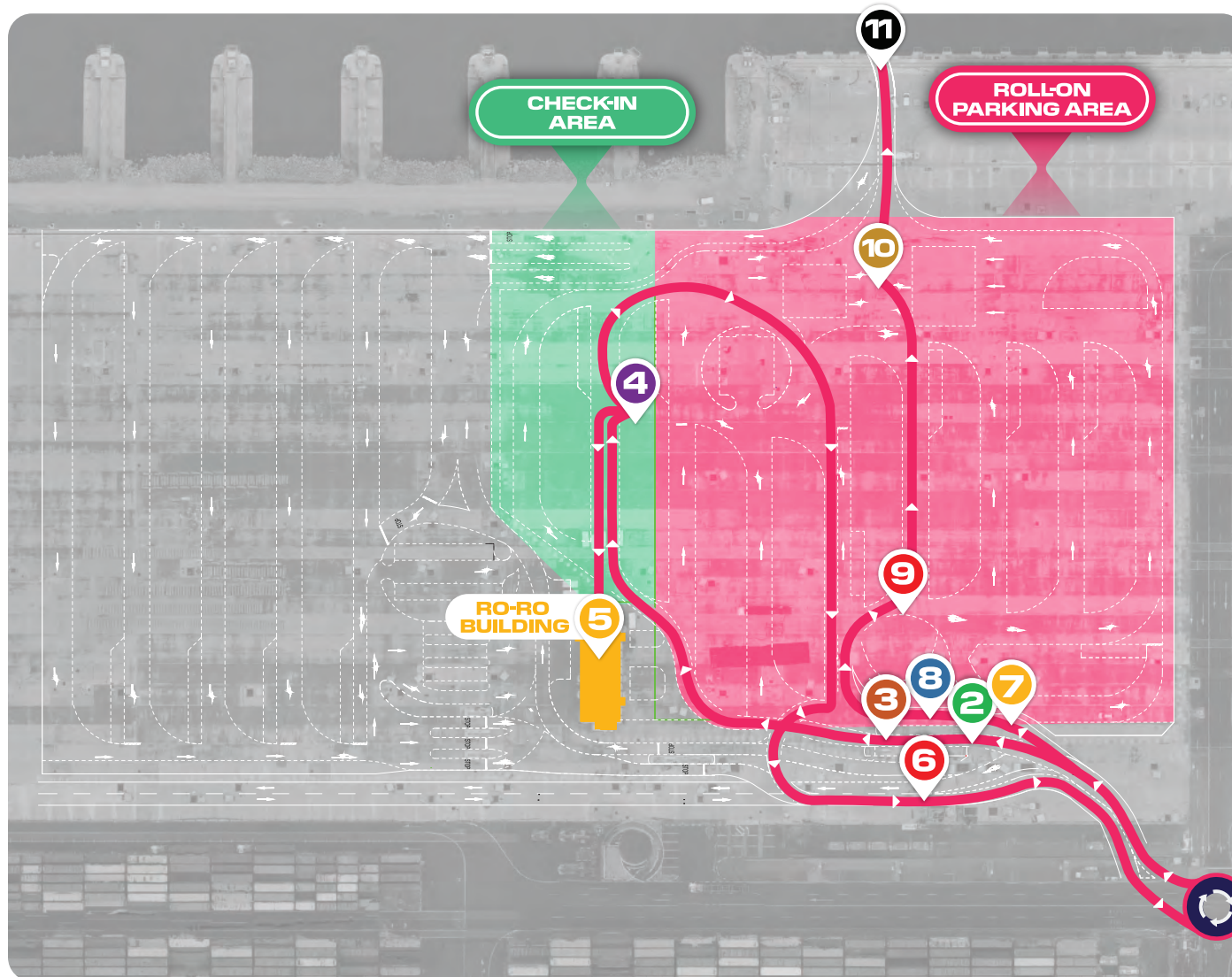

EXPORT



1 STEP 1 & STEP 2

2 SECURITY

Checking Booking and Plate Numbers

- A security agent will check if the trailer and / or truck registration number matches the details on the booking.

3 STEP 3

CNAIR

They check

- CNAIR authority will verify the truck and trailer regarding weight, dimensions and related payments.

4 STEP 4

CHECK-IN AREA

Documentation clearance

- Parking and goes to the DPW Agency desk office.

5 STEP 5

RO-RO BUILDING - DPW AGENCY

Documentation clearance / check-in

- From this point, the authorities may request an inspection of the goods.
- After the documentation clearance you have to exit the check-in area.

6 STEP 6

EXPORT AREA FLOW

- Exit the check-in area through the automatic gate and enter in the export area following the road marks.

7 STEP 7

POLICE

- Present the documents requested.

8 STEP 8

DPW GATE CLERK

- Present requested documents.

9 STEP 9

EXPORT PARKING AREA

Wait for information related to the time of boarding

- A DPW employee will inform you when you are clear to go to the preboarding area.

10 STEP 10

PREBOARDING AREA

Wait for instructions from a coordinator.

11 STEP 11

VESSEL

Board on the vessel.
